Vintage Conditions

The 2014 vintage is already regarded as one of the Hunter Valley's great vintages. With ideal warm and very dry summer conditions, we had the luxury of determining exact picking times which allowed tannin and flavour profiles to fully mature. The 2014 white and red wines will be highly sought after gems, enjoy!

Winemakers Notes

Made from 86% Shiraz and 14% Malbec all taken from our historic Audrey Wilkinson Vineyard. The two parcels of the base wine were made separately, aged in oak barriques for 8 months and handled very delicately to preserve pure red fruit flavour characteristics. Both parcels were then carefully blended for secondary fermentation in bottle. The Cuvée Rouge was matured on yeast lees for 2 years to increase complexity and texture to the wine, which was then disgorged in September 2016.

Tasting Notes

Colour

Deep purple with violet hues.

Bouquet

Rich black cherry, mocha and spice.

Palate

Fresh cherries and mulberry flavours on the palate with a fine and persistent mousse and creamy notes. Hints of savoury spice and mocha also give this wine complexity.
