Rosé

Vintage Conditions

The 2018 vintage will be regarded as a great vintage in the Hunter Valley.

With well below average rainfall through Winter and Spring budburst was two weeks early and in the Summer period, the dry conditions continued. These consistently warm, dry days resulted in the driest year on record and one of the earliest harvests in history and some of the most concentrated fruit flavours we've seen.

Winemakers Notes

Made from Hunter Valley Shiraz and Merlot off our own vineyard, the fruit was crushed together into the press and immediately pressed off, resulting in juice that had the right amount of pink colour. The juice was cold settled for 24 hours, racked clean and fermented at cool temperatures in stainless steel to retain fresh fruit characters. The wine was then sterile filtered and bottled very soon after in order to retain its freshness.

Tasting Notes

Colour

Brilliant ruby red.

Bouquet

Lifted aromas of strawberries, cranberries and hints of rose petals.

Palate

Vibrant strawberries and red berries on the palate with a zesty acidity, giving this wine a refreshingly dry finish.
